Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

DOCUMENT CONTROL

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- 1 This statement is made in accordance with section 54 (1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
- 1.1 Modern slavery is a violation of fundamental human rights and encompasses human trafficking and slavery, servitude and forced or compulsory labour.
- 1.2 Prochainmatrix pledges to ensuring our organisation and supply chain are free from slavery and human trafficking.
- 1.3 During Security Training, our staff receive awareness training of slavery issues and Prochainmatrix actively encourages employees to report any suspicious activity to company directors.
- 1.4 We are committed to improving, monitoring, and maintaining best practice by adopting a zero-tolerance approach throughout all aspects of our organisation.
- 1.5 Through thorough risk assessments we have determined that none of our own business operations are undertaken in higher risk areas, whether by reference to geographical location, business sector or company scale.
- 1.6 It is of paramount importance that we only work with suppliers who treat their obligations regarding modern slavery to an equivalent level of importance as does Prochainmatrix. Therefore, all suppliers must comply with our zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery and human trafficking.
- 1.7 To identify and mitigate risk, Prochainmatrix is familiar with the rigorous policies our existing suppliers have in place. New suppliers must provide details of their existing programme to ensure human trafficking and slavery do not exist in their operations and supply chain.
- 1.8 We will not work with any organisation within our supply chain that is unable to demonstrate a corresponding commitment to modern slavery.
